Withdrawal from Compulsory Courses

When students lack enough learning experiences for such reasons as taking a leave of absence or earning insufficient credits, they may not be able to achieve desired learning outcomes by being placed into compulsory courses. In such a case, students can request a withdrawal from taking compulsory courses in the relevant academic year. They will be allowed to withdraw from compulsory courses if the college deems it appropriate for them to take the compulsory courses in different semesters or take other courses first.

6. Additional registration of courses
