- ◆ Up to 60 credits earned in courses taught entirely or partially via remote learning may be included in the graduation requirements, but credits in excess of 60 credits are optional and will not be counted toward graduation requirements.
Remote courses include online courses (all online), online courses (some face-to-face), and on-demand courses (all on-demand).

However, credits earned from online and on-demand courses offered in AY2020 and AY2021 will not be counted toward the 60-credit limit as a special measure to prevent the spread of the new coronavirus.
