

Cancellation of Registration for Full-Year Courses at the College of Law and Politics

Cancellation of April semester courses is permitted only in cases where registration for Student initiated lectures offered in the fall semester conflict in the day and time with the April semester courses that students have already registered for the full year.

If you wish to cancel a full-year course at the College of Law and Politics that you registered for in the April semester, you must apply through the “[Full Year Courses Cancellation Form](#)” before the deadline.

Period of Application for Cancellation:

[First Deadline] 3:00PM on September 6, 2024 (Fri)

If you apply for cancellation of registration by the first deadline, the course in question will be deleted from the Course Registration System by the start of Primary registration period for fall semester course code and lottery registration (11:00 a.m. on September 10, 2024 (Tue.)).

*If you have applied for cancellation, please confirm that the course name does not appear on the Course Registration status screen that will be updated at 11:00 a.m. on Monday, September 16, 2024.

[Second Deadline] 3:00PM on September 19, 2024 (Thu)

If you apply for cancellation of registration by the second deadline, the course in question will be deleted from the registration system by the start of the course change period (11:00 a.m. on September 26, 2024 (Thu.)).

*If you have applied for cancellation, please confirm that the course name does not appear on the course registration status screen that will be updated at 6:00 p.m. on Saturday, September 28, 2024.

Cancelled courses that are not included in the maximum number of registered credits.

*Please note that from the AY 2024, students will be allowed to cancel a full-year course only when they register for Student initiated lectures offered in the fall semester, which overlaps the day and time of a full-year course offered by the College of Law and Politics in the April semester.
