

AY2025 Designated Year

- (1) Students shall, in principle, take courses in the designated semester.
- (2) Students in the upper years can take courses assigned to lower years. As a general rule, for courses that are not permitted except for the assigned year, refer to the course list below.

Designated to first-year students

*1 You may register for 基礎文献講読 in the second year if you took a leave of absence in the spring semester of the first year.

*2 If you are a second year student or above enrolled in the Teacher Training Course and have not completed the subjects (Operation of information equipment) stipulated in Article 66-6 of the Educational Personnel Certification Law and the Teacher’s License Law, you can follow a separate procedure.

- (3) Students in the lower years are not allowed to take courses designated for upper years (or semesters). However, this does not apply to courses with certain eligibility requirements.
 - * Note: Some courses have prerequisites in addition to the designated semester to determine eligibility.
 - * Rules for taking courses that apply to students who have taken a leave of absence. The year of students who have taken a leave of absence advances automatically until the fourth year regardless of the number of semesters enrolled. In these cases, students are allowed to take courses assigned to the year (or semester) they have advanced to, unless the college/department/program determines otherwise.
