AY2025 · 2026 Student-Initiated Special Lectures

1. Overview

Students at this university who wish to set up Student-Initiated courses must determine the purpose, contents of lectures, and requested lecturers. They must submit a proposal to the faculty meeting, signed by 20 or more students. The faculty meeting will then decide whether or not to accept the proposal, and the course name shall be "Student-Initiated Special Lecture." In principle, student-initiated courses shall be offered as two credits per half-year, for a total of eight credits or less in the academic year.

The above proposal should be submitted to the Ikebukuro Campus' Academic Affairs Office, where the necessary forms will be provided.

2. Deadline for applications

- (1) The deadline for fall semester courses in the academic year 2025 is 5 p.m. on Tuesday, May 20, 2025.

- (2) The deadline for spring semester courses and fall semester subjects in the academic year 2026 is 5 p.m. on Thursday, November 20, 2025.
 However, for fall semester courses in the academic year 2026, an application period will be set separately in May 2026

only if the number of credits does not exceed the set limit of eight credits for the relevant academic year. Please check the R Guide for academic year 2026.
