

## Free Elective Courses Curriculum Revision

Changes in Language A/B free elective courses due to the introduction of New Curriculum after 2024

### 1. Course registration policies and procedure

Be sure to read university-wide liberal arts subjects pages 38 to 42 in the Course guidebook for first-year student in 2024 (distributed in 2024) about course registration policies and procedure. The following points to be discontinued after 2024.

#### Details of discontinue

- Language A (English) free elective courses: The maximum number of credits that can be applied for among “qualification courses”, in the independent module, and courses “other than qualification courses” is 6 in each semester.
- Language A (English), Language B (German, French, Spanish, Chinese, Korean, Russian): Students who have completed compulsory courses are eligible to take free elective courses.
