

## AY2026 College of Intercultural Communication 専門演習 1/Advanced Seminar 1 Application

### 1. Course registration policies

- (1) Students in the General Course and TBP Course:  
You must review the details in Section 7-1, "Advanced Seminar 1–3," under the Curriculum Regulations for the Department of Intercultural Communication (General/TBP) in the Course Guidebook.
- (2) Students in the DLP Course (enrolled in or before 2023):  
You must review the details in Section 2-3, "Advanced Seminar 1–3 [Compulsory Courses]" under the Curriculum Regulations for the Department of Intercultural Communication (DLP) in the Course Guidebook for their year of enrollment.
- (3) Students in the DLP Course (enrolled in or after 2024):  
You must review the details in Section 5-1, "Advanced Seminar 1–3" under the Curriculum Regulations for the Department of Intercultural Communication (DLP) in the Course Guidebook for their year of enrollment.
- (4) Students in the ICGL Course:  
You must review the details in Section 4-1, "Advanced Seminar 1–3," under the Curriculum Regulations for the Department of Intercultural Communication (ICGL) in the Course Guidebook.
- (5) Contact the Academic Affairs Center in the following cases:  
If you fail to earn credits for "Advanced Seminar 1–3."  
If you take a leave of absence.  
If you plan to take "Overseas Study Program" during your 3rd year.  
If you plan to participate in an outbound exchange program during your 3rd year.

### 2. Selection method

In principle, you should make an appointment for an interview with the faculty member whose seminar you want to take (though an interview may not be required in some cases)., fill in the required fields in the application form, and apply during the designated application period.

### 3. Application method and course registration

#### (1) Interview

Make an appointment with the supervising faculty member whose seminar you want to take and conduct an interview. Although you can conduct an interview with multiple professors, you can apply for only one seminar in primary and Secondary registration.

#### (2) Primary registration period

A registration page for "Advanced Seminar 1" will be set up on Canvas LMS (scheduled for late April). Please register for the specific 専門演習/Advanced Seminar you wish to join. Within the "Assignments" section of that course, submit the required documents including your grade report, research theme, and reasons for choosing the instructor during the designated application period. Please note that you can apply for only one faculty member, even if you conducted interviews with multiple professors. If you submit applications for multiple faculty members, all of the applications will be considered invalid.

#### (3) Secondary registration period

If you did not pass the primary selection process, you may submit another application during the secondary selection period (Please note that it is not possible to change the faculty member if

your application has already been approved in the primary selection). Please register for the specific 専門演習/Advanced Seminar you wish to join on Canvas LMS. Within the "Assignments" section of that course, submit the required documents including your grade report, research theme, and reasons for choosing the instructor during the designated application period. Please note that you can apply for only one faculty member, even if you conducted interviews with multiple professors. If you submit applications for multiple faculty members, all of the applications will be considered invalid.

(4) Third registration period

If you have not been assigned a faculty member in the primary or secondary selection, you may apply during the tertiary selection period. (Please note that it is not possible to change the faculty member if your application has already been approved in the primary or secondary selection). Fill in up to five faculty members whose seminars you would like to take in the online application form, attach a screenshot of your grade report and submit it during the designated application period.

(5) Course registration

The university registers students based on the selection results. Students should confirm that they have been registered correctly on the course registration status screen.

#### 4. Points to note regarding selection

(1) There is a limit on the number of students for 専門演習 1 to 3/Advanced Seminar 1 to 3.

Please check the limit on the number of students in the Class Registration Method column of the 2026 syllabus.

(2) The supervising faculty member may contact you individually based on the contact information provided at the time of application. Please provide the contact information the faculty member can use to communicate with you in a timely manner.

(3) **【General / TBP / DLP (Students admitted in FY2024 and later) / ICGL】**: If you did not apply within the designated period (including students on leave of absence) or did not pass the selection process due to invalid applications, “卒業課題/Senior Project A/B” will be automatically registered during your seventh semester of enrollment.

**【DLP (Students admitted in FY2023 and earlier)】**: If you did not apply within the designated period (including students on leave of absence) or did not pass the selection process due to invalid applications, you will enroll in the Advanced Seminar 1 to 3 designated by the department. However, if you were on leave of absence during the application period, you may be allowed to change the supervising faculty member by conducting a return to school interview before the start of the semester you are returning to school.
