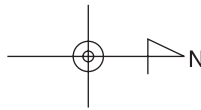
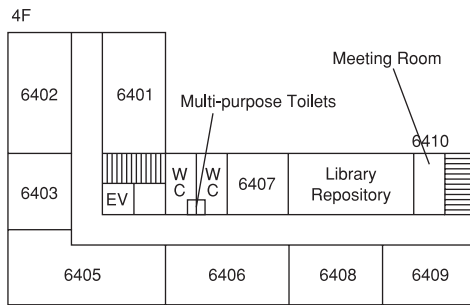
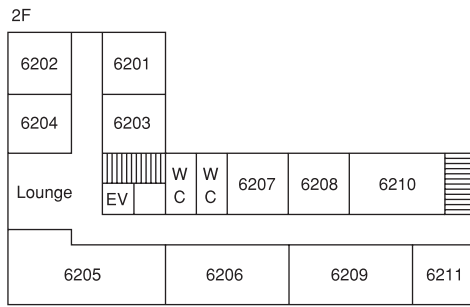
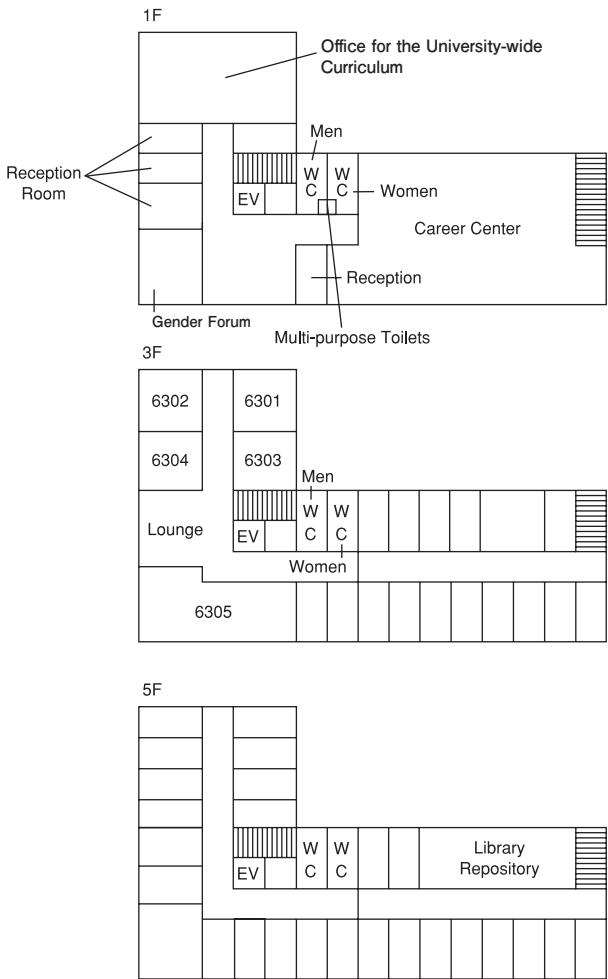
Indicates the floor.

Classrooms in Blocks B and C in Building No.5 are numbered in the 20s.

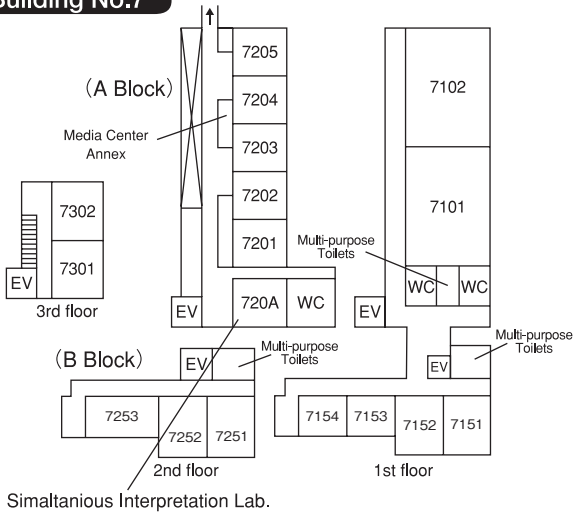
