

**AY2026 Cancellation of Registration and Application
for Registration of "Legal Presentation" and "Legal Writing"**

- (1) Course registration and cautions
 - (i) In the first-year students of the Department of International Business Law, Global Program, classes are designated by the department, and either the Standard class or the Advanced class is registered in advance by the university, so there is no need to apply for course registration. The classes to be registered are announced on the course registration status screen. The specified class cannot be changed.
 - (ii) Those who wish to cancel their spring semester “Legal Presentation” must apply through this [application form](#) by 12:30 p.m. on Saturday, April 4, 2026.
 - (iii) Those who wish to cancel their fall semester “Legal Writing” must apply through this [application form](#).

Period of Application for Cancellation:

[First Deadline] 4:00PM on September 3, 2026 (Thu)

If you apply for cancellation of registration by the first deadline, the course in question will be deleted from the Course Registration System by the start of Primary registration period for fall semester course code and lottery registration (11:00 a.m. on September 8, 2026 (Tue)).

*If you have applied for cancellation, please confirm that the course name does not appear on the Course Registration status screen that will be updated at 11:00 a.m. on September 14, 2026 (Mon).

[Second Deadline] 4:00PM on September 18, 2026 (Fri)

If you apply for cancellation of registration by the second deadline, the course in question will be deleted from the registration system by the start of the course change period (11:00 a.m. on September 26, 2026 (Sat)).

*If you have applied for cancellation, please confirm that the course name does not appear on the course registration status screen that will be updated at 6:00 p.m. on September 19, 2026 (Sat).

- (2) Students eligible for course registration

Limited to first-year students of the Department of International Business Law, Global Program.

Exceptions

If you have not completed the credits "Legal Presentation" and "Legal Writing" in the first year and wish to register for a course in the second year or later, you need to make course code registration. Select the class you want to register for, either the Standard class or the Advanced class, and register for a course. Since the course code differs by class, check the course code in the course list of R Guide.
