

About the Kushibiki Award

The Kushibiki Award of the College of Law and Politics of Rikkyo University is a scholarship funded by donations made by an alumnus Mr. Hironori Kushibiki to Rikkyo Gakuin. The purpose of this award is to encourage the academic achievements of third-year undergraduate students (for September entrants, in their second or third year) at the College of Law and Politics who study abroad at a partner institution through Rikkyo University's student exchange programs or interdepartmental agreements of the College of Law and Politics. The award is granted to the student with the highest academic performance, as determined by their grades by the second spring semester (for September entrants, by the spring semester of the first year).

Application requirements: Students in the College of Law and Politics enrolled in the second year of undergraduate studies at the time of application and are applying to study abroad at a partner institution. In the absence of applicants, the Kushibiki Award for that academic year will be marked as "Not applicable."

Number of selected persons: One

Selection: In principle, the selection is based on document screening.

Scholarship amount: 500,000 yen (grant)
